ABOUT THIS SEMINAR

Agile Project Management is a very flexible way to scale up from just one team to multiple team environments and still stay within time and budget and a high Return on Investment. Agile is known for an iterative approach to develop requirements and an incremental delivery. This way clients don't have to wait and first business value is achieved without having to wait for the deployment of the full solution. The parameters 'time', 'costs' and quality are fixed and requirements can vary based on the exploring character of Agile.

We all know this. Issue is often to integrate a team in a larger environment and still keeping all the advantages of working Agile. The umbrella Agile covers multiple methods. The training Agile PM introduces the full delivery from early contact with the client to development and closure using a multiple Agile stack (DSDM, XP, Scrum, TDD, Lean, KanBan principles, etc.), all executed based on the Agile values, principles and techniques.

This training provides participants with the Agile philosophy, the full project cycle, a glossary (based on the Agile Foundation exam from the Agile Consortium), roles needed outside the development team, business participation, Agile success factors and Agile Foundations.

WHAT YOU WILL LEARN

Participants will learn how to tailor the full delivery cycle to the needs of a specific project, how to work with teams as a project manager, in teams as a team member, how to manage Agile environments as a line manager that facilitates the team and concepts for team development and how to implement Agile successfully.

OUTLINE

WHY

Agile is not “do as we like”. The success of Agile comes with the quality and discipline applied when we use Agile techniques. Understanding WHY of Agile helps to better use Agile techniques and will motivate people to apply quality and discipline when they work Agile.

HOW

Quality in applying the Agile techniques is essential. So what exactly does this mean. The HOW of Agile, across methods, will get a lot of time and attention during this training.

Agile full delivery Project Cycle

Often teams jump into development, deliver the software and meet unhappy customers and run over time and budget. They missed some serious topics needed to achieve the required business value. What does the full cycle, fully Agile exactly mean. Mr. van Bennekum will take you from the greenfield to implemented changes and achieved business value.

Foundations

Often Agile teams jump into development or they have to wait for ages before they can get started because of bureaucracy. What you need is an Agile start to create a fundament to close a project successful or to be able to keep on developing in a sustainable rhythm. Mr. van Bennekum will teach you how to do it, with whom and when.

Agile Management

Agile means working with self-organising teams. What does this mean and do you create and maintain self-organising teams. Mr. van Bennekum will teach the means of vertical commitment and support needed to get there.

Roles and Responsibilities

Not just developers but all stakeholders need to be addressed. Mr. van Bennekum will teach the participants how to recognise them and involve them.

Agile Techniques

Mr. van Bennekum will teach the group the essential Agile techniques. They are not just tricks but part of the essential Agile Mindset to achieve success working Agile.

Quality

Agile requirements flow and testing, we make complex solutions for complex situations. Predicting in detail what the requirements should be is therefore impossible. So you have to explore, even during the development. Question is how do you make the requirements surface, how do you validate and verify them and last but not least, how do you do this and still create high quality of code and business value? Mr. van Bennekum will take the group on the journey and will give them concrete examples how to do, manage and monitor this and still stay within time and budget.
